Students in Stage 3 are invited to our 2022 Overnight Excursion.

On Friday 2<sup>th</sup> September, students will travel by bus to Revolution Sports Park to enjoy the trampoline and bubble soccer experiences.

Afterwards we will have lunch and travel to the Newcastle Museum to see the science show, 'Planet Earth' which relates to our current science unit.
