Students must read a certain number of books to complete the Challenge.

Challenge	Number of books you must read	Minimum number of PRC books	Maximum number of Personal Choice books	PRC booklists you can read from
K-2	30	25	5	K-2, 3-4, 5-6
3-4	20	15	5	3-4, 5-6, 7-9
5-6	20	15	5	5-6, 7-9
7-9	20	15	5	5-6, 7-9

K-2 students can read the books on their own, read them with someone or have someone read the books to them. Years 3-6 students must read the books on their own. Teachers will log books on the PRC website for students in K-2, however, students in Years 3-6 must log them independently.

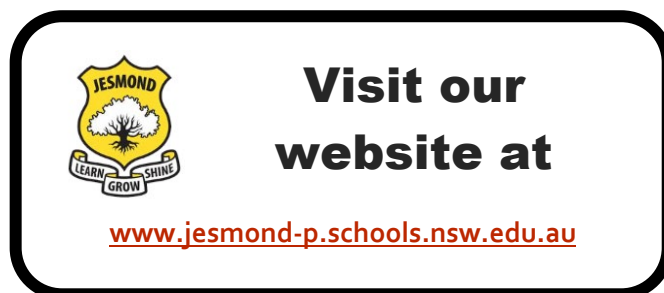

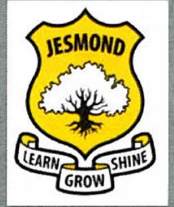
